



Le Rosey Summer Camps 2012

Financial conditions

Upon payment enrolment becomes official.

Upon receipt of the application form, we will inform you whether places remain available at the camp(s) chosen and will request a **registration fee of CHF 1000**, to be paid by bank transfer. Upon receipt of your payment, we will proceed with your application.

The remainder of the invoice (camp fee, including pocket money and minus the registration payment) will be sent at a later date. This must be settled within 30 days of the billing date.

Camp fees are quoted in Swiss francs; if a payment is made in a foreign currency, the exchange rate of the day of the transaction will be used; any difference in favour of the payee will be credited, or, in the case of a shortfall, a further payment will be invoiced.

We do not accept payment by credit card.

The cost of each camps **includes**

- accommodation in a twin room, in tents or mountain refuges
- provision of bed linen, personal and bath towels
- full laundry service (except dry cleaning which is not provided during the camps)
- the courses according to the programme
- the sport and associated coaching offered within the programme
- evening activities
- excursions, cruises and optional weekend activities
- accident insurance, personal liability insurance and local taxes
- transport to and from Geneva airport but only on the official days of arrival and departure. Outside these dates, transport by taxi will cost approx. CHF 120 for Rolle or CHF 500 for Gstaad.

Camp fees **do not cover the following expenditures** (which will be deducted from the pocket money):

- medical care in case of illness (accident costs are covered)
- various personal expenses (telephone, stamps, fax, excess baggage, UM service, etc.)

There is no insurance against theft; all extra money held by the students should be handed in to the Direction or the Head of House for safe keeping.

It is strongly recommended to not bring jewellery or valuable items.

!THE COST OF THE EXCELLENCE CAMP includes

- reception at the airport and transfer to Gstaad; overnight in Gstaad
- all activities, materials and meals during the Mountain week
- the flight at the end of the Mountain week and transport to the Ipharra
- all activities, materials, excursions, sports, lodging and meals on board the yacht
- flight back to Geneva at the end of the Sea week
- sickness and accident insurance, including medical repatriation in case of emergency and personal liability insurance for each participant.

LE ROSEY AVENTURES RESERVES THE RIGHT:

- to cancel one of the sessions up to three days before the session begins and should this case arise, will re-imburse the moneys paid and will propose the option of joining in one of our other Rosey camps
- to adapt routes or camp itineraries should security issues arise relating to adverse weather during the course of the Mountain or Sea camp

Cancellation conditions

We strongly recommend that parents take out cancellation insurance in the student's country of residence in order to ensure full re-imburement for cancellation before the start of camp or in case of early departure from camp (for example, in case of accident, illness, family problems...).

The registration fee of CHF 1000 is non-refundable and non-transferrable.

Cancellation policy :

- Up to 30 days before the start date of the camp : 50% of the cost of the camp and full re-imburement of the pocket money
- After this period, the full amount (registration fee and camp fee) is due. Pocket money is re-imbursed in full

In case of litigation, the competent Tribunal is at Rolle.
